PROPOSE CAMP SWIMMING  
POOL - LACI SMITH

For many campers at Camp Bud Schiele, the lake is the place where most of their spare time is spent. Whether they're swimming, boating, or simply relaxing, the waterfront allows campers of all ages to enjoy a break from the heat in the form of fun aquatic activities. However, as many have noticed in the past, this high demand for water-based fun can quickly cause the swimming area to become very crowded, especially during recreation time.

Order of the Arrow members from Eswau Huppeday Lodge recognized this issue and decided to take action. Alan Turing, who was a camper at Camp Bud Schiele last summer, took on the challenge of coming up with his own solution. He and a group of other OA members came up with a plan to build a swimming pool to reduce the amount of strain on the waterfront. Although it seemed plausible at first, the group would find it difficult to come up with a plan that seemed doable.

One big concern was money, since such a large project would require significant funds. Because of their involvement in the OA, the group decided that they would aim to have the project funded by the Lodge, who have been known to fund camp improvement projects in the past. However, they didn’t think their current ideas were

realistic in either the budget or execution.
