Registration Requirements for OA Events

It is the policy of the Boy Scouts of America National Office, that all participants in the Order of the Arrow must be current registered members of the BSA. In an effort to ensure that all leaders and youth are currently registered, the lodge will be requiring membership cards at all lodge events; including Ordeals. Please make an effort to ensure that you have a current (dated) membership card showing your registration with a unit and/or district.

Starting immediately, each brother will be asked to show his/her BSA membership card at OA events. In the event that he/she does not have a card, his/her name will be recorded and checked at the council office for registration number. At the next event, this person **MUST** have a card or have proof of membership, failure to do so will violate the national policy guidelines. Without proof of membership, we will ask that the person please not attend the event as this would put our lodge in violation of the guidelines we have been given.
